## 40 Days for Life in Indianapolis

St. Jude parishioners are being called to participate in the **National 40 Days for Life** campaign, a focused period of time of prayer and fasting for the end of abortion. From February 17 through March 28, 2010, Monday - Saturday 8:00 AM - 6:00 PM and Sunday 12:00 Noon - 6:00 PM, a peaceful prayer vigil will take place in front of Planned Parenthood, Indiana's largest abortion facility at 8590 Georgetown Road, on the Northwest side of Indianapolis. 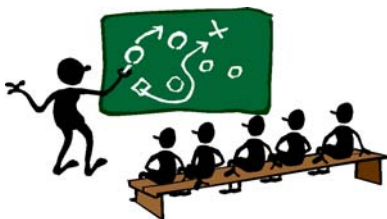
