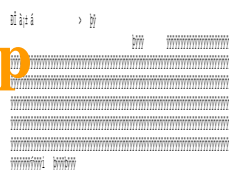

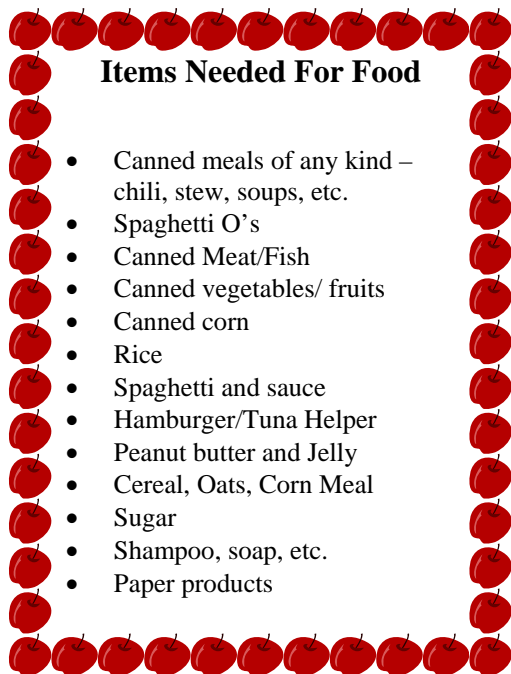

### St. Jude School Tuition Rates

Thank you for choosing St. Jude School for your children. Many of you sacrifice greatly to ensure your children receive an excellent academic and Catholic education. New 2010-11 tuition rates for full day Kindergarten and Grades 1 through 8 will be as follows:

- 1 student = \$3922.30
- 2 students = \$5940.70
- 3 (or more) students = \$7308.81
- Non-parishioners or "inactive" parishioners for 1 student = \$6138.00.
- Half day Kindergarten tuition for each student = \$1961.15
- Half day Kindergarten student of Non-parishioners or "inactive" parishioners for each = \$2550.00

## June 11 The Blind Side

Inspirational family drama, based on real events, in which a wealthy white couple in Memphis, Tenn., offer shelter to a homeless black student from their children's school and as he becomes an increasingly integral part of their clan, help him to hone his football skills while also hiring a determined tutor to raise his academic standing. Adapted from Michael Lewis' 2006 best-seller "The Blind Side: Evolution of a Game," is funny, shrewd and ultimately uplifting. (PG-13) 2009

## July 16 Boy in the Striped Pajamas

The 8-year-old son of a Nazi concentration camp commander befriends a captive Jewish boy and is gradually exposed to the horrors of the Holocaust. This luminous screen version of John Boyne's award-winning novel for both children and adults contrasts its protagonist's innocence with the brutal irrationality of the events he uncomprehendingly witnesses. Mature thematic material, including a disturbing but nongraphic mass extermination scene. (PG-13) 2008

## August 6 The Kite Runner

Fine adaptation of Khaled Hosseini's best-seller about an Afghan writer now living in the U.S. who recalls how as a boy in his native homeland he failed to help and subsequently betrayed his best friend and now finds he has a chance to atone for that misdeed. Sensitive direction and beautiful performances add up to a fascinating portrait of pre- and post-Taliban Afghanistan with fine human values, strong affirmation of friendship and family, and redemptive ending that should move even the most stone-hearted (PG-13).
