Thank you for choosing St. Jude School for your children. Many of you sacrifice greatly to ensure your children receive an excellent academic and Catholic education. New 2010-11 tuition rates for full day Kindergarten and Grades 1 through 8 will be as follows:

1 student = \$3922.30

2 students = \$5940.70

3 (or more) students = \$7308.81

Non-parishioners or "inactive" parishioners for 1 student = \$6138.00.

Half day Kindergarten tuition for each student = \$1961.15

Half day Kindergarten student of Non-parishioners or "inactive" parishioners for each = \$2550.00
