## **Dress Code and Code of Conduct**

*You are representing your parish and the Archdiocese of Indianapolis; therefore, appropriate dress and conduct that reflects Catholic Christian values is expected at all events.*

### **DRESS CODE:**

- Pants & shorts must be worn at the waistline - no sagging or undergarments can be visible.
- Shoes or sandals must be worn at all times.
- Shirts/tops must have an appropriate neckline (no lower than 4 finger-widths from the collarbone).
- Shoulders and stomachs must be covered; no mesh or see-through clothing
- No spaghetti straps, halter tops, tube tops, or sport bras. Tank top straps must be at least 1½" in width.
- Appropriate length shorts must be worn – walking short or school uniform approved length.
- Tight-fitting clothing is never allowed and undergarments must not be visible through the clothing.
- No t-shirts with alcohol, cigarettes, or disrespectful/offensive sayings or logos.
- If your attire is determined to be inappropriate, you may be asked to wear a t-shirt or be sent home.

### **CODE OF CONDUCT:**

- The possession or consumption of any alcohol or tobacco is NOT allowed.
- The possession of illegal drugs or weapons will result in having local police contacted.
- No foul or inappropriate language.
- No PDA (public display of affection) is allowed, including but not limited to kissing, holding hands, or inappropriate touching.
- Throwing of objects and loud or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- You are expected to respect your peers, adult chaperones, leaders, and guests.
- Dance moves should be tasteful (i.e., no body surfing, most pits, or grinding).
- No carrying people on shoulders.
- No back talking.
- You are to remain at the event for the duration.
- If you are asked to leave the event, you may not return.
- You are required to abide by the Dress Code.
- Your parents will be notified if you fail to abide by the rules.
- Youth are expected to respect their peers, the speakers, and adult leaders who are there to assist them.
- Participants are expected to attend all Rally events.
- Nametags must be worn at all times. They will allow admission to all activities, including the concert and the dinner.
- Dress for the Rally is casual, no clothing with obscene or offensive language, symbols or pictures will be permitted.
- Participants are to remain in Roncalli High School during the duration of the Rally and in St. Jude Church during the duration of Mass.

## Guideline for Adults

*All adults must have completed Virtus training and a background check.*

- All adult chaperones are responsible for helping enforce Rally Code of Conduct.
- Each adult is responsible for the youth assigned to them and arrange check in times throughout the day. Please review the Code of Conduct with all participants.
- All adults and youth are expected to attend all Rally events.
- Each parish leader must provide their own first aid kit.
- Adult participants are to refrain from drinking alcoholic beverages and smoking during the duration of the Rally and while in the presence of the youth before or after the Rally.
- Adult chaperones do not have eth authority to adjust the schedule or change Code of Conduct.
- Adults are to be with their parish youth during the large group gatherings in the Auditorium, walking to and from Mass, during Mass, and at dinner. Do not hesitate to give proper guidance to any youth that may be disrupting or distracting others.
- Group leaders are responsible for the actions of their participants. Each parish will take full responsibility for any damage or theft done by their group at any Rally activity.
- One designated parish leader should pick up the registration packets for their entire group on Saturday, January 16 between 12:30-1:30pm.
